Welcome to the Town Belt Traverse

The Dunedin Town Belt is one of New Zealand's oldest reserves and has a rich history reaching back to the early planning of Dunedin. The Town Belt covers 203 hectares and includes two cemeteries, numerous parks and also the Woodhaugh and Botanic Gardens.

Today the Town Belt is an important recreational and ecological asset for the city and provides invaluable habitat for native birds.



The traverse starts from 10.00 am and all participants must complete the traverse by 1.30 pm to be eligible for entry to the prize draw.

Collect stamps at all 5 stations along the walk, enter your contact details and go into the draw for some of our great prizes. Entries with all 5 stamps will be eligible for the prize draw at the end of the traverse.

Be Safe and Have Fun

The traverse is not a race but an opportunity to enjoy and explore the Town Belt. The course covers 8 kilometres and is designed for fun, fitness, and understanding of the reserve.

All participants should have good shoes, wet weather gear (hopefully not required), a drink and be prepared to take a break and admire the scenery. The route has utilised existing pedestrian crossings with other road crossings being marshalled by Rotary volunteers so please use these points for your safety and use the tracks, paths and safest parts of the road as you go.

- There are arrows highlighting the route so please follow them.
- Please note that dogs are not allowed into the grounds at Olveston.
- A bus is available for transport from Woodhaugh Gardens back to the Southern Cemetery.
